

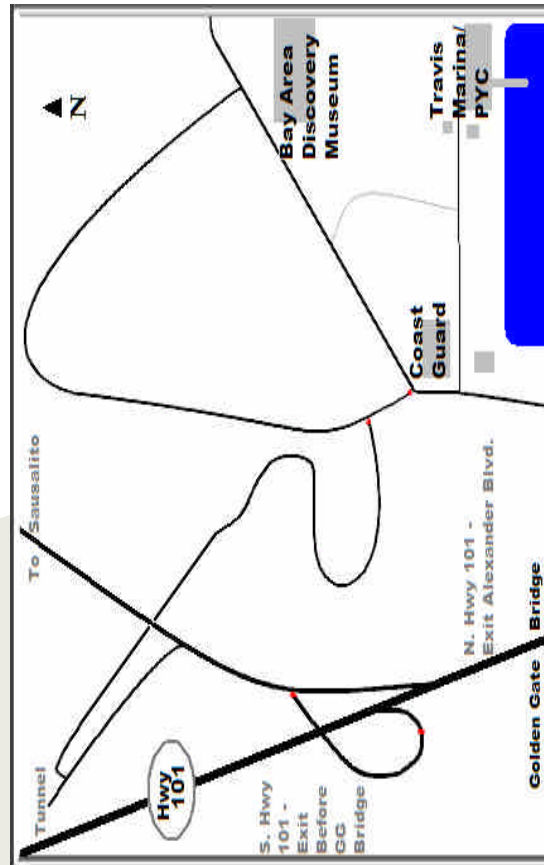
## How to Get Here...

### South on Highway 101

Drive south on Highway 101 towards San Francisco. Take the last Sausalito Exit before the Golden Gate Bridge. When exiting, turn **Right** at the stop sign. This will take you under Hwy 101. Pass 2nd stop and continue approximately 1/8 of a mile, turn **Left**. Turn **Right** before the tunnel. Wind yourself down the road until the next stop sign across from a large meadow. Turn **Right**. After one more stop sign, continue straight towards the waterfront. Turn **Left** after the tree in road and drive along the water front over to Travis Marina/PYC.

### North on Highway 101

After you come off the Golden Gate Bridge, take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit – Alexander Avenue, go 1/8 of a mile and Turn **Left**. Turn **Right** before the Tunnel with the traffic light. Wind yourself down the road until the next stop sign across from a large meadow. Turn **Right**. After one more stop sign, continue straight towards the waterfront. Turn **Left** after the tree in road and drive along the water front over to Travis Marina/PYC.
